RIBBON PRINTING

Ribbon printing is a major fundraiser for our school that we do in term 3 each year. We print and cut about 3000 award ribbons for <u>Vetora</u> (our Group Day sponsor) and approximately 15 other schools.

We make around \$7000.00 profit to help your child's education.




