For now to get started you will ned to download the HERO app onto your phone. Use your email address you have connected to our school when you sign in and select "New User" I have added a "How Too" page to the newsletter.

Once you have set yourself up on the app you will then be able to use the absentee button to register when your child is away, click the link to order lunches and keep up to date with the latest news of the school through community posts. As we progress through the year you will also be able to check in on your child's progress through their learning journey and see their assessment results. You will also be able to see your school finances, see what's owing and print your own receipts. We believe that Hero will change the game in terms of school communication and strengthen the Teacher/Parent relationship.

We will definitely need to be patient with each other in these early days of adapting! 




