### 4 SELECT "SUBMIT"

Hero will send you an email with a link to follow.

### 5 CHECK YOUR EMAIL

You should receive an email within five minutes.

### 6 FOLLOW THE LINK

This will take you to a secure page to enter your chosen password.

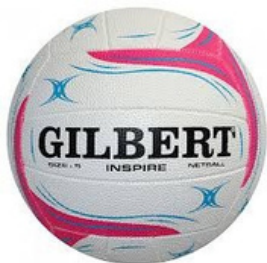
